Children's Cancer Connection, since 1988, has focused on the mission of enhancing the lives of children and their families affected by childhood cancer who are living, treated and/or diagnosed in the state of Iowa. The Ockenfels' Family Foundation's mission strives to be a caring member of the childhood cancer journey, no matter where that journey takes an individual and their family.

Eligibility to apply for Children's Cancer Connection Empowering Scholarships

- Applicant must be directly affected by childhood cancer (includes individuals who currently have or have had cancer before age 18, or a sibling of that individual)
- Applicant must be within Children's Cancer Connection service area (living, treated or diagnosed in the state of Iowa)
- Applicant must attend an accredited two or four year institution (trade school, college or university)
- Applicant must have a minimum GPA of 2.5

Requirements for Children's Cancer Connection Empowering Scholarships

- Completed application with written two 500 word essays
- Two letters of recommendation from school, medical or business professional
- If selected, scholarship recipients will need to complete 10 40 hours of volunteer support dependent upon awarded scholarship

Available Children's Cancer Connection Empowering Scholarships

- \$500 Book Reimbursement Scholarship
- \$1,000 Tuition Assistance Scholarship
- \$2,500 Tuition Assistance Scholarship
- \$5,000 Debbie Ockenfels Memorial Scholarship



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Applications for the Fall Semester are due the last Friday in May.

Applications for the Spring Semester are due the last Friday in September.

Applicants will be notified by July 31 for the Fall Semester and November 30 for the Spring Semester. Funds will be sent directly to the institution listed in the application.
